

The purpose of this grant is to supplement travel expenses and registration costs of attending an academic conference. Applicants can receive up to \$100 for the conference registration fee and up to \$200 for lodging and transportation costs. If more than three students are attending the same conference, the maximum amount awarded may be reduced. Each student can only receive ECOS funding for a conference one time per academic year.

This grant proposal must have a sponsoring professor, and their signature is required on this form. This application must be turned in two weeks prior to the conference. If your grant is approved, you will be notified and must turn in ITEMIZED RECEIPTS within two weeks post-conference. Only receipts for lodging, transportation, and conference registration will be reimbursed.

- 6. Will you be receiving funding from any other sources outside of ECOS? (Ex. Ford Apprentice Scholars, collegium funds, scholarships, etc.)
